Under the Affordable Care Act (federal health care reform law), most individuals are required to have qualifying health coverage, or pay an Internal Revenue Service (IRS) federal tax penalty.

Previously, you received IRS Form 1095-B, which is your proof that you and/or others in your home had qualifying health coverage during months you were enrolled in Medicaid or Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+) in 2015. This form may help you avoid paying a federal tax penalty.

You are receiving this letter because a change has been made to the **Form 1095-B: Health Coverage** tax document for you or someone else in your household. The “CORRECTED” box on the top of your IRS Form 1095-B is checked because the information on the form has been changed. The corrected form is included with this letter.

This document is for tax purposes only. Keep IRS 1095-B forms with your other tax documents.

Who do I contact for help?
