

An Important Message from the Health Care Authority

The enclosed IRS Form 1095-B is for everyone who received Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) for one or more months of 2015. The individuals listed on this 1095-B had minimum essential coverage (MEC) last year through Apple Health.



Why am I getting this form and what do I do with it?

This form is a new tax document. It provides information you will need if you file taxes. Whether you file taxes or not, keep this form for your records.

To find out if you have to file taxes or should file them even if it's not required, please visit www.irs.gov or consult a tax professional.



Is all Apple Health coverage MEC?

Not all Apple Health coverage is minimum essential coverage. If you or someone in your household had coverage that is not MEC, then that information will not be included on the 1095-B form.



What if information is incorrect or missing from my 1095-B or I need a replacement form?
