Example Consumer “Frequently Asked Questions” (FAQs) for the 2014 Tax Season

Frequently Asked Questions – for States to Answer:

1. Q: How can I find my 1095-A form?

A: Marketplace to mail; post PDF to account (not all states).

2. Q: I don’t agree with some of the information in my 1095-A form. How do I fix it?

A: Call 1-XXX-XXX-XXXX, visit [this web site], or visit in-person [location]. The Marketplace will send a corrected 1095-A form based on...

3. Q: What is the “monthly premium amount of second lowest cost silver plan” and how do I find it for every month in 2014?

4. Q: I had a baby in the middle of the year. Is she part of my coverage family and should she be listed on my 1095-A form?

A: If she is your dependent or the dependent of someone with whom you file jointly,...

5. Q: I was approved for an exemption from coverage last year. Do I need a 1095-A form?

A: If you were exempt from coverage for every month in 2014, you do not need a 1095-A form...

6. Q: I received two 1095-A forms. Which do I use for my tax returns?

A: You should use the most recent 1095-A form... If you received more than one, the “Corrected” box at the top should be checked...

Frequently Asked Questions – for the IRS to Answer:

1. In filling out my tax forms, it looks like I owe back some of the tax credit I received. How is this possible when I only received what the Marketplace told me I was entitled to?

2. I had coverage for most of the year. Do I owe money for the months I didn’t have coverage?

3. If I don’t submit this form, will I still get my tax return?

4. My income dropped mid-year and I became eligible for Medicaid. Do I owe money for the months I was on Medicaid?

5. My husband/wife and I divorced mid-year. Which of us is responsible for money we owe?
